ONE YEAR GOALS

- 1) Continue to improve Math Instruction Delivery Model and improve Achievement Test scores in Math by utilizing small group instruction to better differentiate instruction for all ability levels.
- 2) Adopt and implement a Writing Curriculum aligned to state standards through continued staff development.
- 3) Continue to improve Reading Instruction and Achievement Test Scores in Reading by adopting a Reading Series that aligns to State Standards. This series should enhance our Guided Reading Program in grade K-2nd grades.
- 4) Work with District 843, Manhattan 114 staff, and new 114 Curriculum/Special Education Director to review our current model of services offered to IEP students.
- 5) Work with District 843, Manhattan 114 staff, and new 114 Curriculum/Special Education Director to develop a plan for implementation of a Response to Intervention (R.T.I.) Program.
- 6) Continue to build upon our Character Counts Character Education program through monthly classes that students will attend and a student incentive program.
- 7) Continue to improve a School Safety Plan in conjunction with our local fire and police departments.
- 8) Continue to plan for future enrollment growth.
- 10) Continue to build a strong partnership with our families and the Manhattan community.

THREE – FIVE YEAR GOALS

- 1) Increase the percentage of students who meet/exceed standards in Reading and Mathematics on our district assessments.
- 2) Continue to build a strong partnership with the community of Manhattan to address the needs of a growing school district.
- 3) Continue to build a positive and safe learning environment for children.
- 4) Continue efforts to be current in terms of research and practices related to effective schooling.
