- Manhattan's student population has been demonstrating steady growth over the past several years increasing an average of 25 students per year over the previous 5 year, based on the Fall counts.

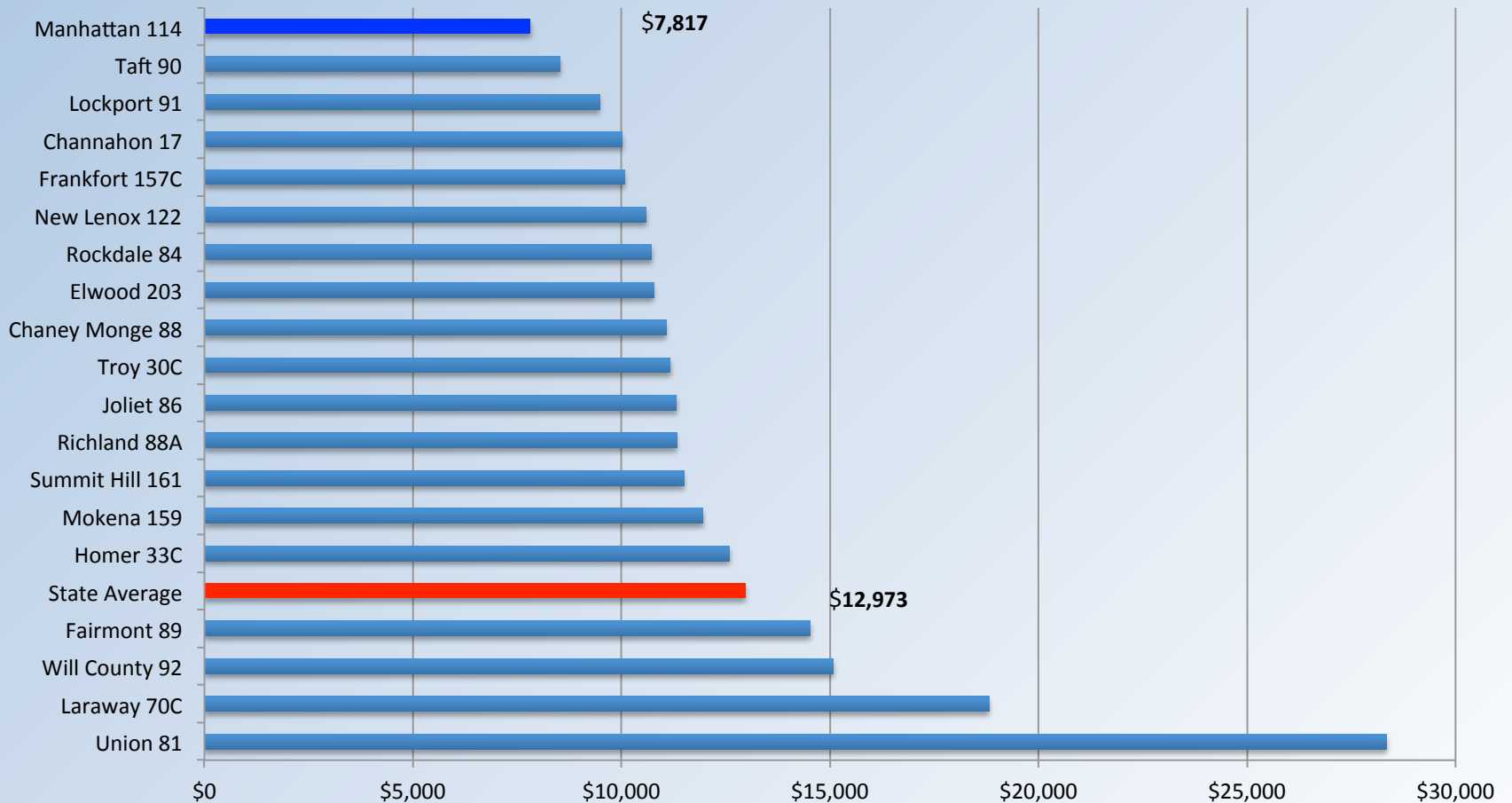

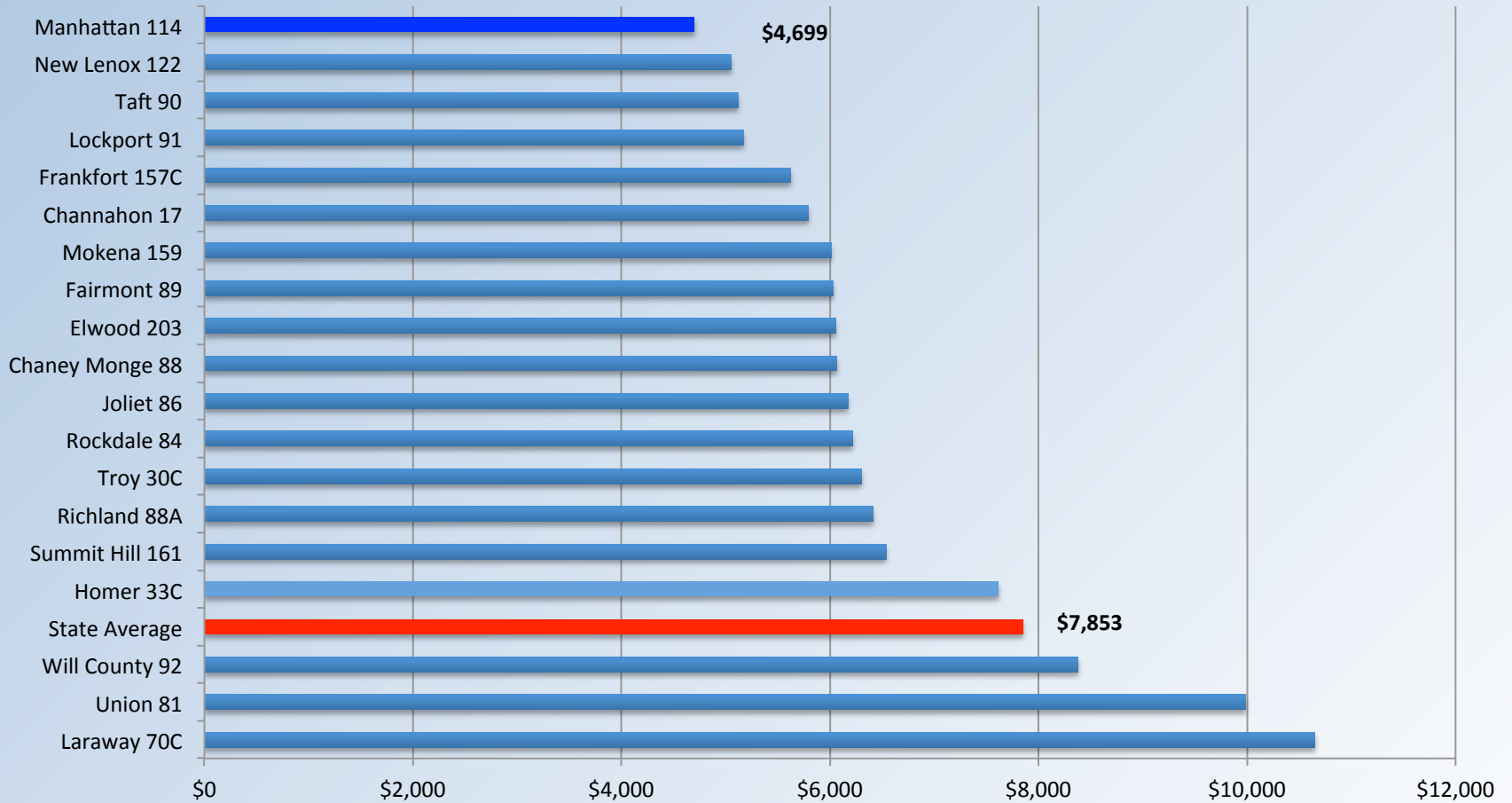
Current Enrollment

- **September 30, 2017 Student Enrollment – 1464 (+ 2.4%)**
 - *Enrollment stands at 1464 students, up 34 students from our 2016-17 Fall enrollment count on Sept. 30.*
 - *Projecting an increase for 2018-19 as the Village projects a possible 100-125 new homes to be built. New homes going up in Sunset Lakes, White Feather, Western Springs, and Hanover Estates.*
 - *Another 2.5% increase would add an additional 35 students for the 2018-19 school year and push the enrollment above 1500.*
 - *The current rate of growth would have Manhattan 114 exceeding 1500 students by the start of next year, 2018-19.*
 - *Projected housing estimates will likely lead to an increased growth rate, leading to an increased student enrollment of 50-70 students per year.*

WILL County Schools Operational Spending Per Student

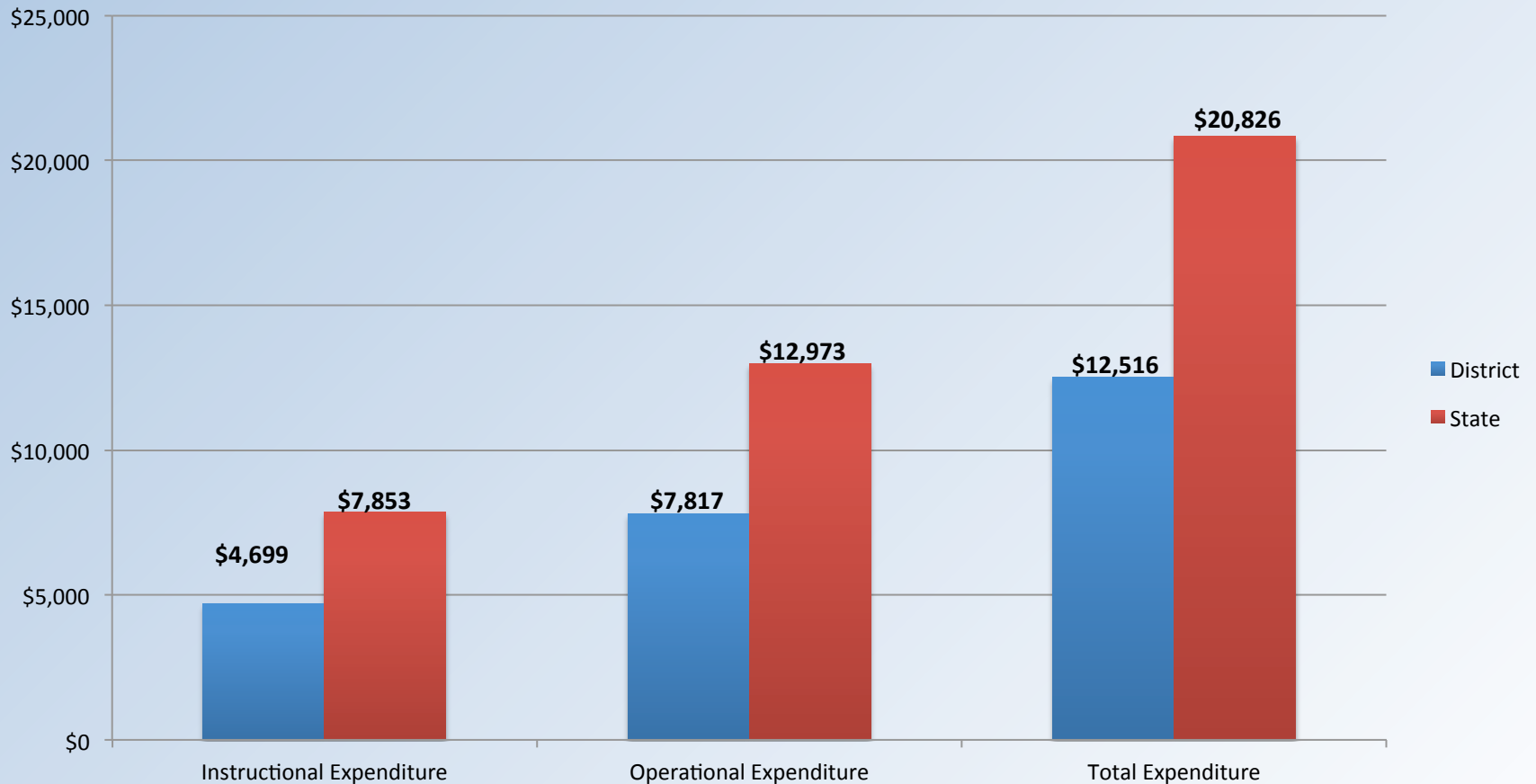


WILL County Schools Instructional Spending Per Student



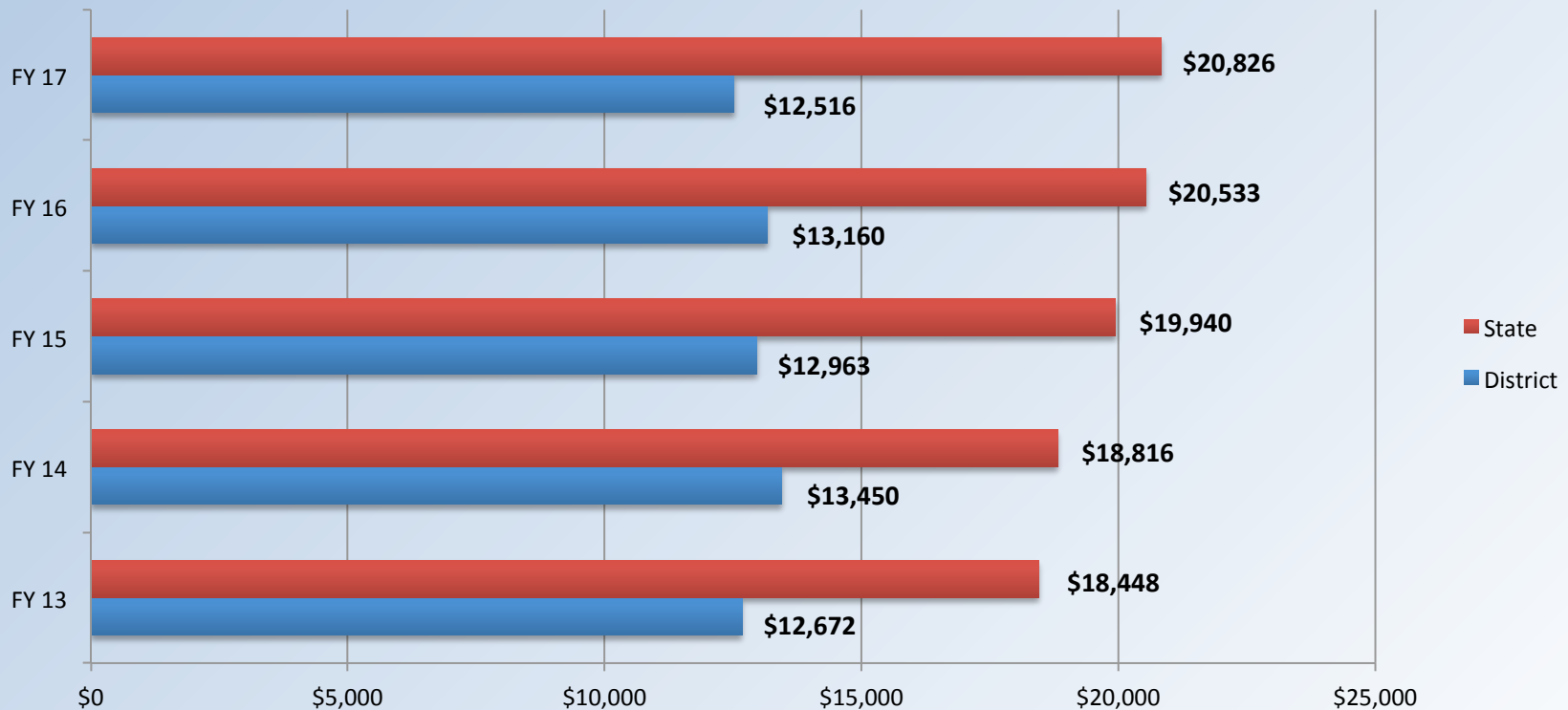
Expenditures Per Pupil

- The district continues to provide quality education at a cost to the tax-payer less than the state's average. D114 spends \$12,516 vs. State's \$20,826.



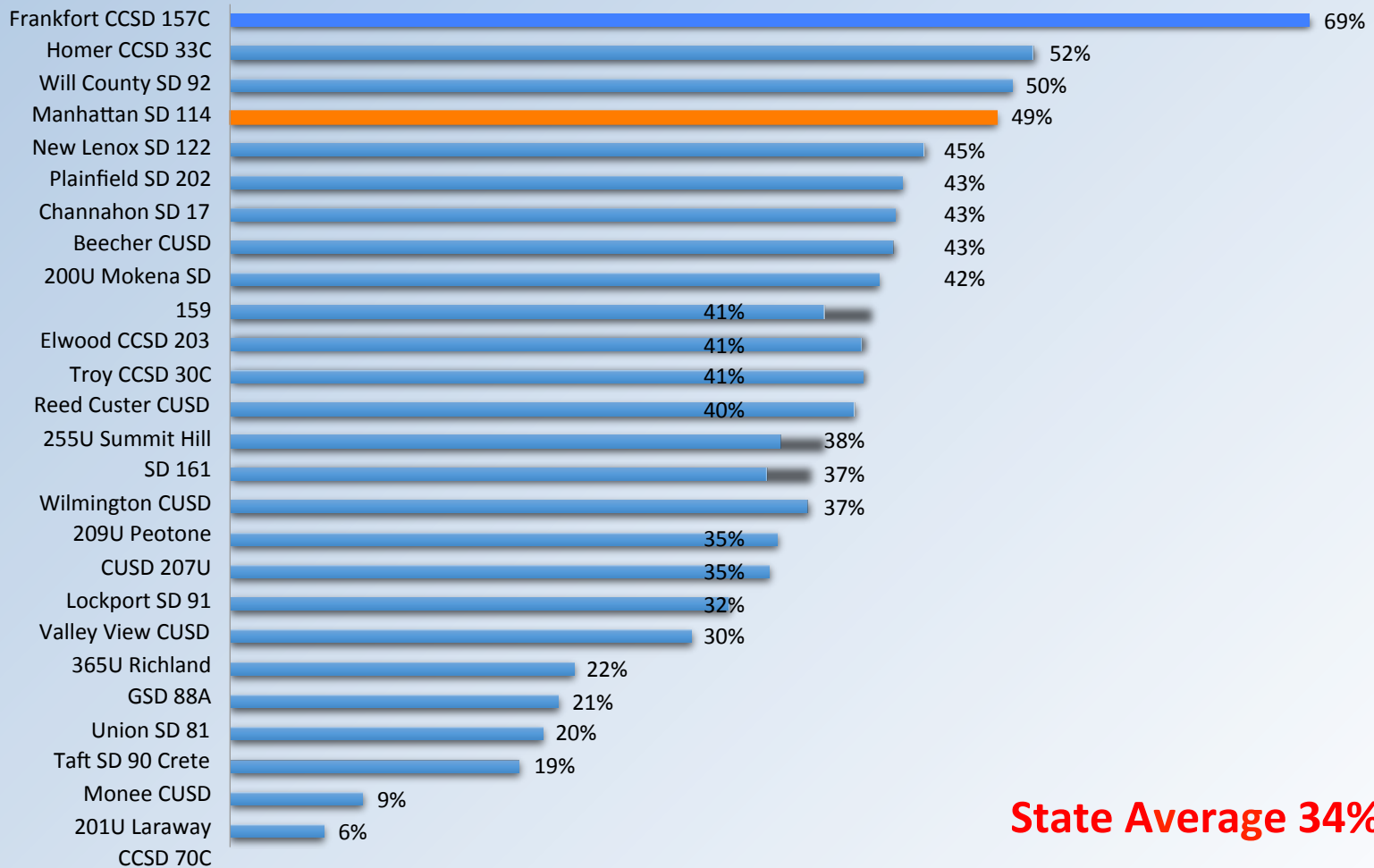
Expenditures Per Pupil
